

Paint Recipes

Soap Paint

Warm water
3 cups soap flakes
Food coloring

*Add water, a little at a time, to detergent flakes.
Beat to consistency of heavy cream.
Color with small amount of food coloring.*



Finger Paints

2 cups flour
2 teaspoons salt
2 1/2 cups cold water
2 cups boiling water
Food Coloring

Mix the 2 cups of flour with the 2 teaspoons of salt. Add the 2 1/2 cups of cold water; stir until smooth. Gradually add this mixture to the 2 cups of boiling water. Boil until the mixture becomes smooth and thick. Add the food coloring until you get the desired color.

Puff Paint

1 Cup Salt
1 Cup Sugar
Food Coloring

Mix together the three ingredients. The best way to use it is from a squeeze bottle. Squeeze paint out of the bottle onto paper!



Footpath Paint

1/2 Cup Water
1/2 Cup Cornstarch
Approximately 12 Drops of Food Coloring (This can be adjusted until you get the desired color)

Measure the water, cornstarch, and food coloring into a jar. Place the lid on the jar tightly. Shake the jar until the paint is completely mixed. Do this for every color you want to make. The paint is now ready to use on your concrete. . If the paint gets a little too dry, simply add a little bit of water. When you are done playing, this sidewalk paint can be washed off using a hose.
